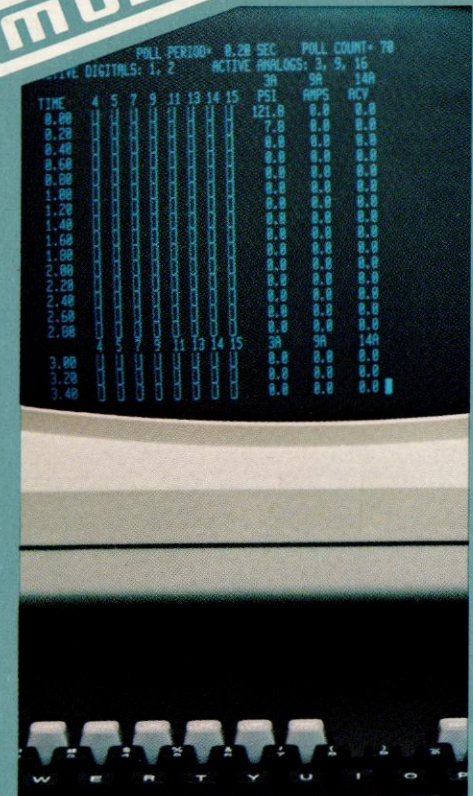

Via telephone, the system monitors virtually every machine function without human communication. Within minutes, up to eighty individual points are isolated and analysed — including digital and analog functions. Potential malfunctions as well as intermittent problems can be detected.

MultiScan™ is a diagnostic service rather than just a tool. Simply dial a number, start the machine and wait for a reply. Most problems will be diagnosed in minutes.

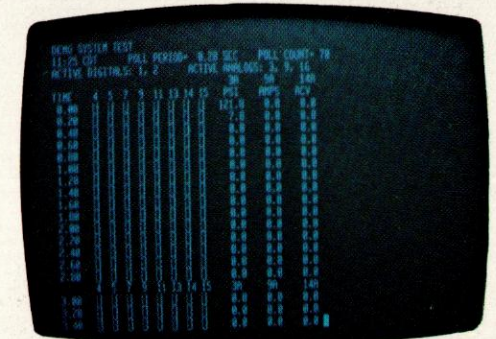
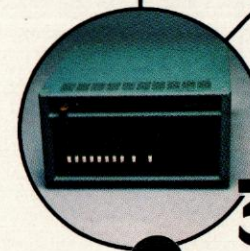
1 The method is simple. All you do is plug the monitor box into the packaging machine and dial the automatic-answer data base modem.

2 When the data base modem sounds the tone, your call has obtained access to our Kansas City computer. Start the machine and let it run two or three minutes. Push the stop button and hang up the phone.

3 Data will automatically be recorded on floppy disks by the data base computer at Koch.

4 As soon as you hang up the phone, the Koch operator in Kansas City will push the "print-out" button and the data base computer will produce a graph of the data received.

5 By analyzing the graph, the operator will be able to pinpoint the cause of any problem occurring during the time you transmitted data.
