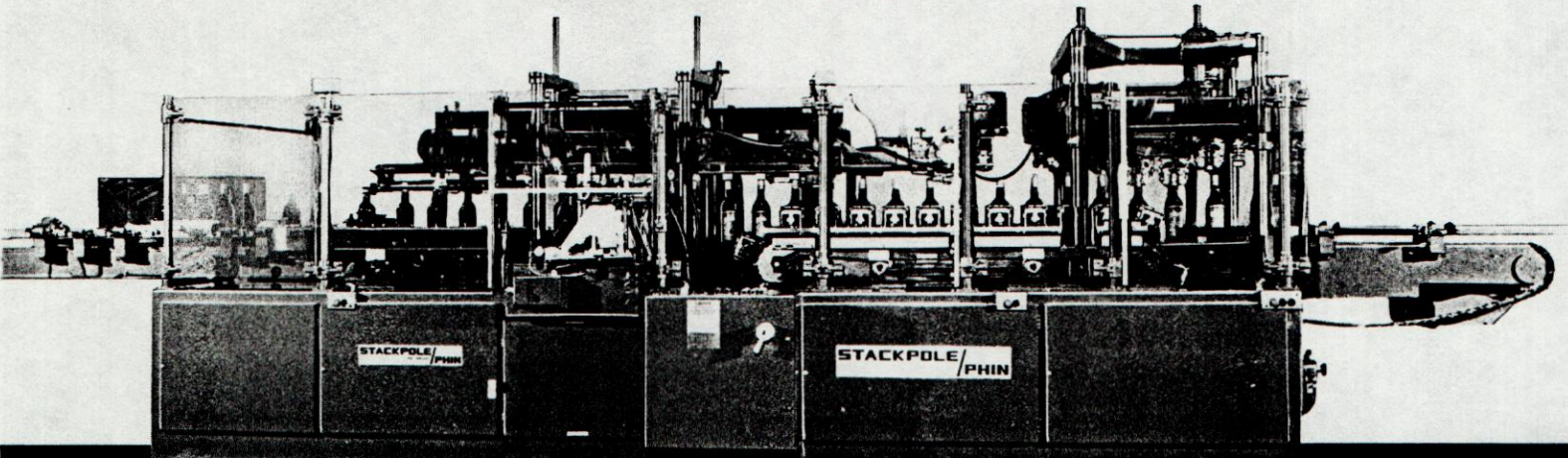


The outstanding result of combining the SM 1700 labeler with a tax stamper.

- Low torque, high speed central drive shaft.

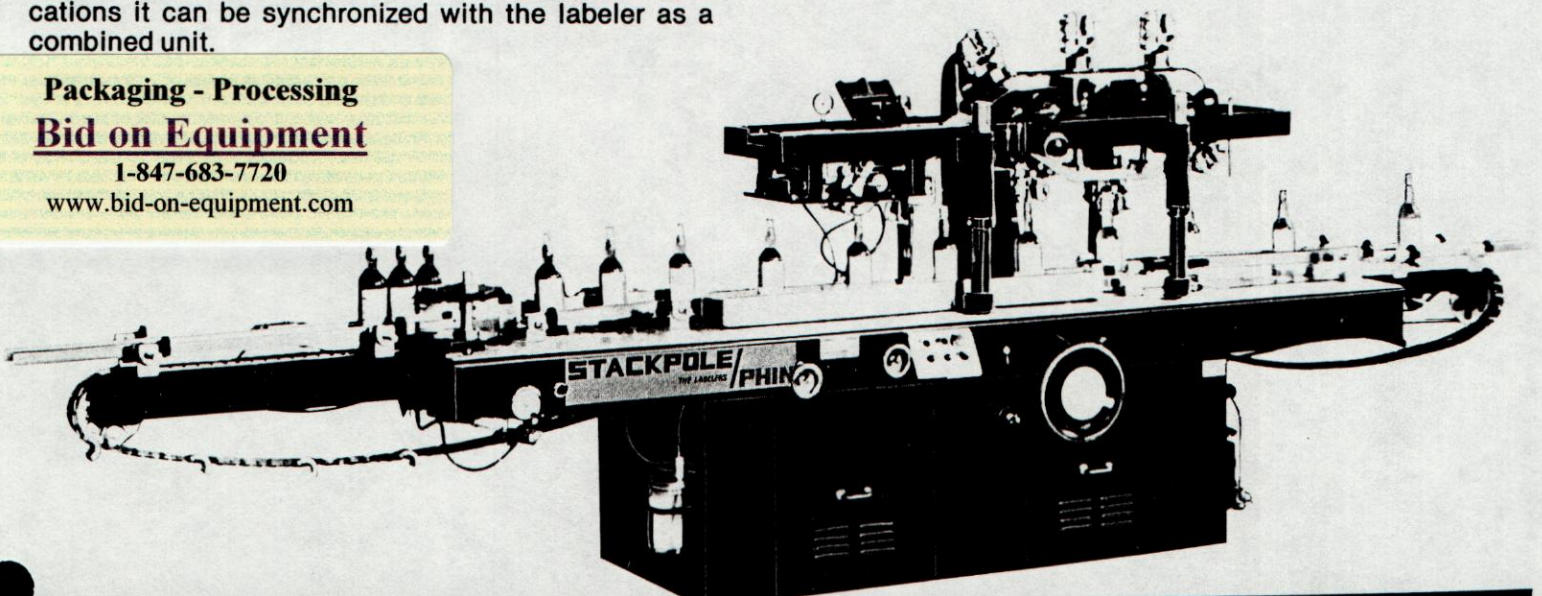
